| <b>RULES</b>             | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Current USA Swimming rules shall govern this meet.</li> <li>All adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming <a href="#">Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy</a> ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.</li> <li>No on-deck USA Swimming registration is permitted.</li> <li>In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In compliance with PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures and/or videos of athletes while they are on the blocks or exiting the pool (e.g. cell phones, cameras, etc.) is strictly prohibited. Credentialed and Meet Host, pre-approved media personnel are permitted to take pictures and/or videos of athletes after they have entered the pool and before exiting the pool.</li> <li>Deck Changes are prohibited.</li> <li>Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.</li> <li>Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.</li> <li>Dive-over starts may be used. Swimmers will then proceed from the Clerk of Course to the deck area where they will line up behind the blocks.</li> <li>• One-way traffic will be maintained on the pool deck at all times. Swimmers will access the pool deck through the emergency entrance door in the main hallway and will exit the pool deck through the locker rooms. They will exit the locker rooms and return to their assigned team areas using the main hallway.</li> <li>• There will be limited seating on the bleachers located on the pool deck. Due to limited seating space, parents are requested to only use the seating when their child is swimming an event.</li> </ul> |
