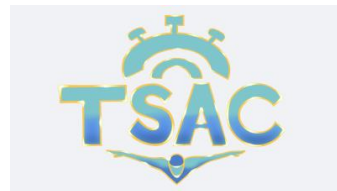

| <b>FACILITY</b>       | <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Fairland Aquatic Center</b><br/>13820 Old Gunpowder Road<br/>Laurel, Maryland 20707<br/>(301)362-6060</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● The pool at Fairland Aquatic Center is 50m x 25yd pool with two moveable bulkheads. Competition will be conducted in 8 lanes in a 25 yard course running from wall to wall. The second competition course will consist of 8 lanes in a 25 yard course running from wall to wall.</li><li>● A minimum of 16 lanes will be available for general warm-up. Continuous warm-up and cool-down will be available if only one course is used.</li><li>● The water depth ranges from 5' – 13' at both the start and turning end of the competition course. If a second course is used the water depth ranges from 5' - 6' at both the start and turning end of the competition course.</li><li>● The meet hosts will ensure the required course dimensions</li></ul> |

| <b>RULES</b>                      | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Current USA Swimming rules shall govern this meet.</li> <li>● All adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming <a href="#">Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy</a> ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.</li> <li>● No on-deck USA Swimming registration is permitted.</li> <li>● In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In compliance with PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures and/or videos of athletes while they are on the blocks or exiting the pool (e.g. cell phones, cameras, etc.) is strictly prohibited. Credentialed and Meet Host, pre-approved media personnel are permitted to take pictures and/or videos of athletes after they have entered the pool and before exiting the pool.</li> <li>● Deck changes are prohibited.</li> <li>● Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.</li> <li>● Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.</li> <li>● Dive-over starts may be used.</li> <li>● The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 &amp; U events per Rule 205.3.1F.</li> </ul> |
| <b>EVENT RULES</b>                | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● All events are timed finals.</li> <li>● A swimmer may enter no more than four (4) events per session and no more than eight (8) individual events for the meet.</li> <li>● Seed times should be submitted in Short Course Yards Only.</li> <li>● The Meet Director reserves the right to alter the format of the meet after entries are received to best accommodate timelines, space availability.</li> <li>● Deck entries will be accepted in available lanes only. No new heats will be created. | <b>WARM-UP</b>                | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director will determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments.</li> <li>● All registered teams will be issued warm-up lane assignments from the Meet Director prior to the start of the meet.</li> <li>● The Meet Director reserves the right to modify the warm-up times and structure, if necessary.</li> <li>● Continuous warm-up/cool down will be available.</li> </ul>                                        |
| <b>SUPERVISION</b>            | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Swimmers must be in direct contact with their supervising coach before they are allowed to enter the pool for warm-up.</li> <li>● Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and for cleaning up their team areas.</li> </ul>                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                  |

| <b>CREDENTIALS</b>            | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position are not permitted on deck. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be permitted on the deck. | <b>PUBLICATION OF RESULTS</b> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● By entering this meet, participants (and their parents or guardians, if applicable) acknowledge and consent to the posting of official meet results on the Potomac Valley Swimming (PVS) website. Athlete birthdates will not be included in any posted results. Meet results may be accessed by third-party organizations or applications that use publicly available swimming data for purposes such as rankings, recruitment, or goal tracking.</li> </ul>                                                                 |
| <b>SPECTATOR ENTRY FEE</b>    | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● No admission charge.</li> <li>● Spectator Seating is limited to 150 people.</li> </ul>                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                        |
| <b>MEDICAL ASSISTANCE</b>     | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Medical supervision will be provided by the facility staff. | <b>FACILITY RULES</b>         | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Swimmers are not to leave the pool deck without appropriate attire.</li> <li>● Glass containers are not permitted within the pool area.</li> <li>● Camera cell phones are not permitted in the locker rooms</li> <li>● Swimmers should take a cleansing shower before entering the pool for warm-up.</li> <li>● All swimmers and spectators should enter the facility through the pool lobby. Coaches and Officials ONLY may use the side entrance to the pool deck.</li> <li>● Concessions will not be available.</li> </ul> |
